Treasurer's Report 2023-11-05.pdf

- Still need \$5k to meet our No Fuss Fundraising Goal!
- Started the year with excess funds in the operating account \$24,483
 - Excess funds were due to money not being spent over COVID school shutdowns
- Can add some of these excess funds to our current budget if desired, with amendment vote:
 - Proposal to increase School Buildings and Grounds to \$10k to allow more power washing and maintenance to school grounds
 - Proposal to increase Hospitality by \$3k. Food is much more expensive this year and we want to spoil our staff to increase morale.
 - Proposal to add \$125 to Teacher of the Year line item for school based celebration, in addition to banquet.
